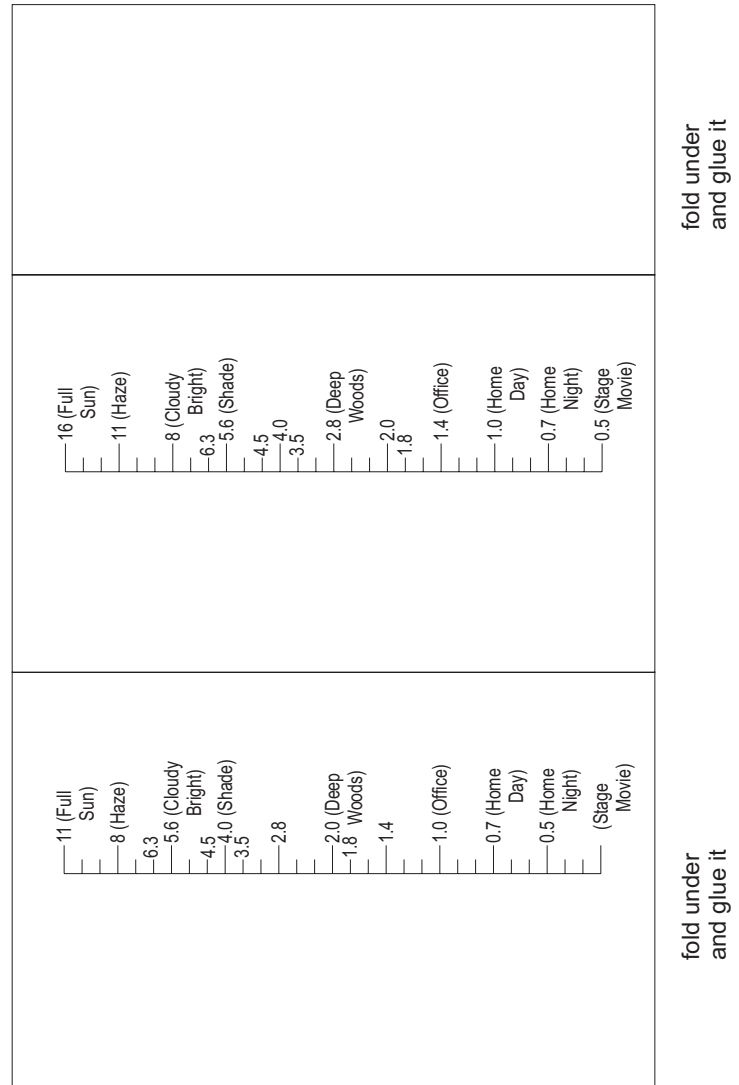
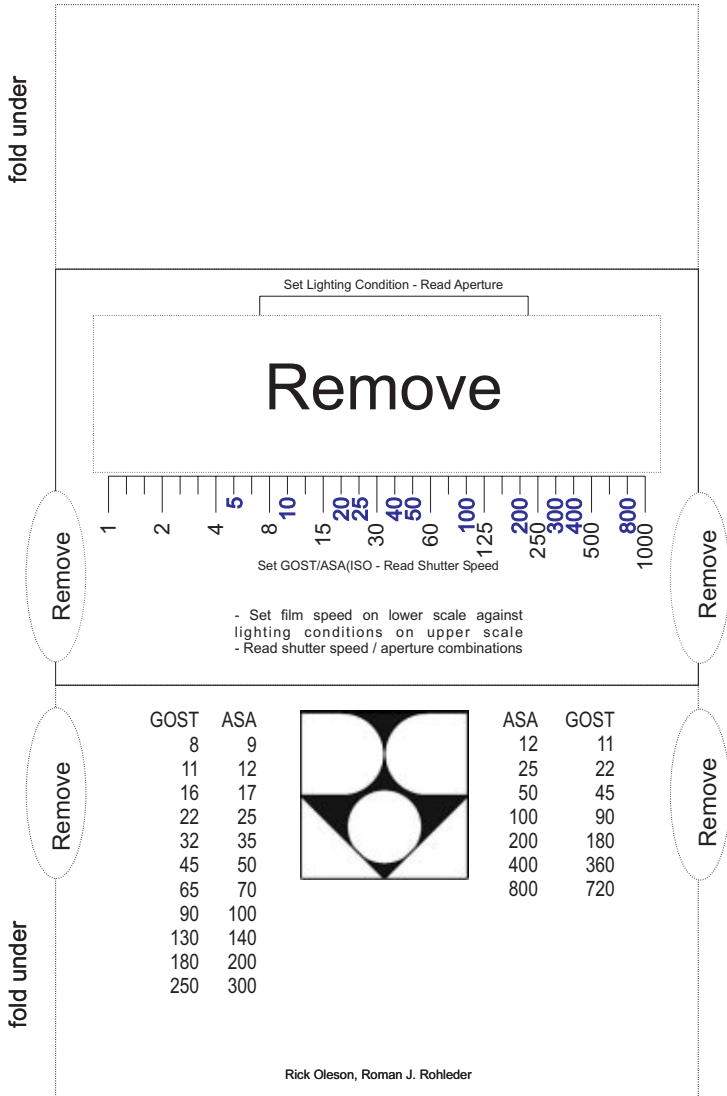


# exposure meter “Tomsk 1(d)”



Print the file either on stronger paper (>120g/qm) or use self-adhesive transparent film. Doing this, remember to use it on the “inside” of the slide window. Otherwise, you’ll be limited to using a single film speed. ;-)

To limit it in use to a single filmspeed, use a strip of Tesa-film to fix the slide.

I have printed mine on colored paper (light blue), so it is easy to spot in my purse with my bank and club cards and still readable under different lighting conditions.
